- **Achiltibuie** **Summer Isles**

Small restaurant, cosy and modern. Good cooking using local produce.
- **Edinburgh** **Number One**
Excellent dining, fine service. Using Scottish produce with originality, passion and skill.

- **Ballachulish** **Ballachulish House**
Formal dining with good cooking and innovation. Set in 1600s house which inspired Stevenson's 'Kidnapped'.
- **Auchterarder** **Andrew Fairlie at Gleneagles**
Stylish modern and discreet. Modern cooking using excellent Scottish produce. Set in world famous hotel, art deco, country house with golf course.



- **Dalry** **Braidwoods**
Remote location. Cosy. Local ingredients with flavour. Good cuisine.
- **Portpatrick** **Knockinaam Lodge**
Shooting lodge dating back to the 1800s. Beautiful coastal setting, good food and service.
- **St. Andrews** **The Seafood Restaurant**
Seafront location, great views of the coast. Elegant style. Fresh seafood, great preparation, friendly service.
- **Loch Lomond, Alexandria** **Georgian Room at Cameron House Hotel**
