- **Chatsworth House and Gardens**

The baroque palace (late 1600s) replaced a Tudor mansion and is now one of Britain's most impressive stately homes. Beautiful gardens landscaped by Capability Brown in the 1760s, include a maze and a spectacular water cascade, French design. The chapel (1693) has beautiful art and marble.

- **Burghley House**

Built late 1500s this dramatic house with a roof of stone pyramids, chimneys like columns and towers like pepper pots. Interior is full of Italian paintings (late 1600s), a banqueting hall, probably the world's largest wine cooler (1710), a kitchen little changed since the 1600s.

- **Castle Howard**

Built in the late 1600s, a spectacular country mansion still owned and lived in by the Howard family. The Great Hall covers 515 square metres (5500 square feet) with a circular gallery. Antiquities from the 1700 and 1800s, art by Reynolds and Pannini.
