England has some of the most beautiful and demanding golf courses in the world. It is possible to be located in London or a large city/town and travel to and play on three or four of these courses on different days. Non golf playing members of the group/family can follow other pursuits.

- The Wentworth Club. Three golf courses. The PGA Championship each May and the World Match Play Championship each October (for the last 30 years).
- Royal Lytham and St. Annes. Long Open Championship history. Very demanding 14th, 15th and 17th. The final hole has wrecked many a reputation.
- Walton Heath Golf Club. Two beautiful heathland courses. Hosted one Ryder Cup and five European Opens. Gorse, bracken and heather punish poor shots.
- Hillside Golf Club. Hosted an Amateur and PGA Championship. Sand hills, deep bunkers, a links course.
- The Berkshire. Has two courses of equal difficulty; narrow fairways between trees and bunkers.
- The Royal Birkdale Golf Club. A links course played along the valleys between the dunes. Professionals have a high regard for the course; often strong winds.
- St. George's Hill Golf Club. Pine-clad hills with heather; 27 holes.
- Formby Golf Club. A beautiful links golf course. Heather, sand dunes, pines, wind provide for a difficult course.

There are some restrictions on these courses, subject to handicap and availability. A handicap certificate might be required together with a letter of introduction. Advanced booking is required.
