In Scotland and Ireland you will find fly fishing waters for salmon, sea trout, wild brown trout, stocked rainbows, grayling and even mullet and bass.

The mountainous valleys of the West of Scotland and the rolling plains of the East provide beautiful, peaceful and unspoiled surroundings.

On the rivers and lochs coarse fishing will provide roach, salmon, perch, pike, carp, brown trout, rudd, trench and bream.

The Scottish lochs are largely uncharted waters. The River Tweed is now famed for its roach fishing. In Ireland the River Shannon, 160 miles long, provides a huge number of specimen fish; bream fishing is arguably some of the best in the world; roach fishing has become a phenomenon; pike fishing is remarkable.

In the sea waters off Scotland and Ireland you will find skate, thornback, conger, cod, mackerel, pollack, haddock, inland trout, salmon, sea bass, wrasse, flounder, whiting, coalfish, blue shark, skate, cuckoo, colly, ling, bull hass, plaice, monkfish, dogfish, turbot, John Dory, ray, tuna, flatfish. Enjoy the magnificent craggy coastline of the Scottish Isles, the hundreds of miles of the Irish virgin shoreline. The never ending Scottish coastline with bays, rocky headlands, islands, sea wrecks, sea lochs, fertile worm beds. The Irish coastline is stunning: some of the most beautiful scenery of anywhere in Europe.



Sea Angling, Ireland



- **The Shetland Islands** have 300 lochs, beautiful, tranquil. (Airport).
- **Western Isles** (Airport). 70 lochs, windy, solitary
- **Lough Corrib**. Trout fisherman's paradise, 30 miles long, 40,000 acres, islands, from shallows to 150 feet.
- **River Blackwater** with hotel dating from 1700s.
- **River Spey**. Classic salmon fishing, beautiful scenery.
- **River Garry**. Three and a half miles of spectacular water, tumbling falls, open glades, beautiful scenery
- **Lough Arrow**. Beautiful landscape, remote, haven for mayfly.
- **Lough Mask**. Limestone lake, 20,000 acres with some of the best trout fishing in Europe. Enchanting, set amongst islands and mountains.
- **Upper River Garry**. Surrounded by mountains, lunar-type loch, throughout the year snow on the mountains, wild deer. Loch is eight miles by one mile.
- **Lochs, Ericht, Rannock, Laidon**. Dramatic Scenery, wild country.
- **River Dee**. Classic salmon river, endless pools
- **Lough Currane**. Magical setting, near the Atlantic. Very beautiful, fishing is free but require a boat.
- **The Sperrins**. Outstanding natural beauty with fast flowing rocky rivers.

Sea Fishing

- **Lochinver**. Busy fishing village with fish market, sheltered location, beautiful scenery.
- **Scottish Islands** (Airport). Low lying, impressive hills, beautiful isolation. Pioneering sensation. Renowned for sea bass.
- **Kinsale**. Fishing port, deep water near the town, big reefs, wrecks (including the Lusitania).
- **Fenit**. Located in a bay, a famous fishing village. Very good boat fishing; if high winds stay in the bay.



Shore Angling, Ireland



- **Cahersiveen.** Beautiful location, small islands, rocks, jetties, harbour, shore and boat fishing.
- **Gairloch.** Sheltered water with beautiful scenery.
- **Oban.** Glens, forests, lochs, streams. Beautiful scenery, area renowned for skate.
- **Tramore Bay.** Claggan Island. Shallow water, often clear, with inlets and bays. Long runs. Breathtaking scenery.
- **Clew Bay.** Sheltered bay with 300 islands.
- **Clogher Head.** Beach and Rock fishing in a beautiful location.
- **Kilrush.** Pier fishing for conger, flounder and dogfish. Safe base on exposed coast.

Coarse Fishing

- **Loch Lomond.** 23 miles long, 5 miles wide. Boats with echo sounders. Excellent pike fishing, also salmon and trout.
- **Highland Lochs.** Beautiful countryside, not easy fishing. Shallow bays, brooding lochs. Remote. Boats normally available.
- **Shannon Loughs. Key, Ree and Inny Bay.** River 160 miles long. Loughs, lagoons, deep glides, gentle flowing, excellent fishing. Beautiful scenery. Attractive villages.
- **Oaucheureoch Loch.** Long natural loch, average depth of 15 feet. Boats available.
- **River Tweed.** Majestic river, beautiful countryside.
- **Loch Awe.** Big loch, remote, inspiring. Boats available.
